There's been this tiny Sticky Note™ clinging valiantly to my wall for 5 years or so. It reads: On Complaining, Judges 6:12-24. "But sir, if the LORD is with us why has all this happened to us. Then the LORD turned to [Gideon] and said, 'Go in this might of yours and deliver Israel . . . I hereby commission you." The vignette makes me laugh and marvel and almost cry at the same time.

(Cheeky) responses (R) to common Bible reading protestations (P):

P: It's boring. R: Uh, Ehud and Jael. (Judges 3:12-25 and 4:1-24)

P: It's bloody violent. R: Yes it is...See: 'human history.'

P: The law stuff is really complicated and bloody. R: Try immigrating or rezoning your property or addressing systematic, age-old injustices. The law is all the more complicated today and costly depending on which side of the tracks you're from.

P: The Bible says X, but we're--or they're--not doing it. What are you, Pastor/Leadership/Conference, going to do about it? R: "Go in this might of yours . . . I hereby commission you." (Judges 6:12-24) See too: the 'Great Commission.'

My point is that the Bible both reflects and addresses our human condition, if not, always directly your or my personal, specific question. The Bible is not meant to be an answer book to your questions, but a guide (and goad), a narrator of our lives whether we do or do not walk in God's way. It is not all about me/us. I think there was a nicer way to have said all this, but I often fail to heed guidance unless its sharp and pointy-like.
