NRSV 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11

¹Now concerning the times and the seasons, brothers and sisters, you do not need to have anything written to you. ² For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. ³When they say, "There is peace and security," then sudden destruction will come upon them, as labour pains come upon a pregnant woman, and there will be no escape! 4 But you, beloved, are not in darkness, for that day to surprise you like a thief; 5 for you are all children of light and children of the day; we are not of the night or of darkness. 6 So then let us not fall asleep as others do, but let us keep and awake and be sober; ⁷ for those who sleep sleep at night, and those who are drunk get drunk at night. 7 But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, and put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. 9 For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, 10 who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep we may live with him. ¹¹ Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing.

Pastor's Corner:

I hear rather timely words in Paul's letter to the Thessalonians as restrictions tighten on an already virus-fatigued population. You don't need more words. We don't know the future, except that God's design is for our salvation through Jesus Christ. So encourage one another (in wise ways.) As our Bible read through comes to an end, these last chapters of Ezekiel and the book of Zechariah are looking forward to a salvation--each book has a different take. While I studied both books in depth in seminary (even translated Zech 1-8), neither book are favorites of mine. What I find really cool though is that God's plan for salvation via Incarnation is so much weirder than Zechariah's dreams and more organic and beautiful than Ezekiel's love of order. What is the beautiful, surprising grace God is lavishing on us at this time? I don't see it yet, but I'd like to know!
